Monthly Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, November 18, 2020

I. Open meeting, President

- A. The Board of Directors meeting was called to order by President Dan Gillins at 16:03 Fastern.

3. At least two directors were present as well as a quorum; therefore, the meeting was authorized.

II. Agenda

A. New recurring meeting time discussion (Gillins)

- 1. Board members agreed to a new recurring meeting the second Wednesday of each month, at 4:00pm Eastern. Please see Section X below.
- 2. Zilkoski suggested that the AAGS Membership Committee meeting be moved likewise from the fourth Tuesday to the fourth Wednesday of each month. This was accepted without objection.
- 3. Schedule rearrangements accommodating Thanksgiving and Christmas were agreed in Section VII.C. resulting in the schedule shown in Section X below.
- B. Upon call for further additions, Martin mentioned the need to renew the trademark for AAGS, and provided a brief preview of the Treasurer's Report.
- C. As moved by Ghilani and seconded by Bean, the AAGS BOD agenda, distributed November 18, was accepted as posted.

III. Minutes

- A. The corrected/finalized October 13 AAGS Board Meeting Minutes were not available.
- B. October minutes will be available before the December meeting, along with the finalized November 18 AAGS Board Meeting Minutes.

IV. Review of Last Month's Action Items and Important Business

- A. AAGS Bookkeeper Robert Jupin retirement; AAGS recognition (Gillins/Martin)
 - 1. Gillins has contacted NSPS Office Manager Trish Milburn to order a plaque of thanks.
- B. Election (Meyer)
 - 1. Meyer has sent ballots to Trish Milburn to distribute to AAGS members.
 - 2. All members are encouraged to vote!
- C. Trademark discussion
 - 1. Bob Jupin's replacement, Christina.Lee@nsps.us.com, has indicated that the AAGS trademark agreement is due for renewal.

Martin elaborated that Lee should be mentioned on the updated trademark agreement. Cost of renewal for five years is \$925 for one class, \$325 each for each additional class.

AAGS uses three classes, for a total of \$1575, due 11/22/2020

- 2. Martin recommended renewing the trademark at this time, and Meyer seconded. There were no objections.
- 3. Meyer discussed the significance of the trademark agreement, which covers the use of the AAGS logo and font.
- 4. Martin will pursue renewal through the USPTO, with a signature from Dan Roman as AAGS Secretary.

V. Treasurer's Report (Martin)

- A. Update on balances
 - 1. General fund: \$44,000+
 - 2. Merrill Lynch: \$46,000
 - 3. Fellowship fund \$8000+
- B. Merrill Lynch (investment account) servicing
 - 1. Merrill Lynch will not be able to service the account in its current form because the account handler has resigned.
 - 2. Merrill Lynch can send AAGS a check, or it can redirect the funds to another investment account, as AAGS directs.

Martin will call Christine Lee to discuss options for a decision in the near future.

- A. SaLIS Ex-Comm (Meyer)

 - 1. Among efforts to increase the visibility of SaLIS, Elaksher has reached out to FIG and ASPRS.
 - 2. ASPRS is willing to include SaLIS information in their journal, asking SaLIS to advertise ASPRS to AAGS members.

Levin discussed development of a special issue of SaLIS

Advertising opportunities for readers to submit papers to FIG conferences and to ASPRS

Elaksher noted that there is little overlap/competition between ASPRS and SaLIS, as they emphasize theoretical research and education research, so this may be a good opportunity

The specific type of advertisement has not yet been specified

ASPRS has big membership, and could encourage submissions to SaLIS. SaLIS readers know about ASPRS already, anyway.

3. Increased visibility through Google, when searching, for example, "surveying journals and magazines"

International researchers need to be able to find SaLIS when searching

Penn State offers a list of surveying journals and magazines² including SaLIS

Meta tags are needed in the header of the AAGS website, to get more hits, e.g. "applied geomatics"

4. FIG conferences have good visibility internationally, but no journal. Would FIG find SaLIS useful?

AAGS is a member of FIG, and FIG receives a copy of SaLIS

FIG would be "a big fish to catch"

Let FIG members know about SaLIS, issuing calls for papers on the FIG website

Contact authors of recent papers presented at FIG, converting conference paper to journal paper
